- Corruption

What policy tools are there available?

Traditional or tribal laws
Community and municipal regulations
National and Provincial Legislation
Regional Policies – SADC, EAC
OAU – African Parliament
Conventions – CMS, etc.
CITES listing
IUCN – SSC, PWG, etc.

What policies are relevant?

Wildlife management legislation **R** Public health Agriculture – use and disposal of chemicals **R** Trade Standards – licensing of chemicals sentence accordingly
